Business:

1. The Board voted to approve the Sewer Bond Sale, as detailed in the memo from Michael Pakstis dated April 30, 2010.
2. The Board voted to call a Special Town Election on Tuesday, June 8, 2010 from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm to approve the action of the April 12, 2010 Special Town Meeting (Article 3, Motion 3) whereby it was voted to appropriate \$1,000,000 for the purchase of 494 Washington Street by the Town.

Furthermore, the Board voted to approve the following question for the June 8, 2010 Special Town Election:

“Shall the Town vote to approve the action of the representative Special Town Meeting of April 12, 2010 taken on April 14, 2010 whereby it was voted to appropriate \$1,000,000 for the purchase of 494 Washington Street by the Town; and authorize the Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Selectmen to borrow said sum; and authorize the Board of Selectmen to take all necessary action to complete said purchase. (Article 3, Motion 3).”
