ALERT: REDUCE OUTSIDE WATER USE

Dear Wellesley Water Consumer:

We now need your help to reduce lawn irrigation!

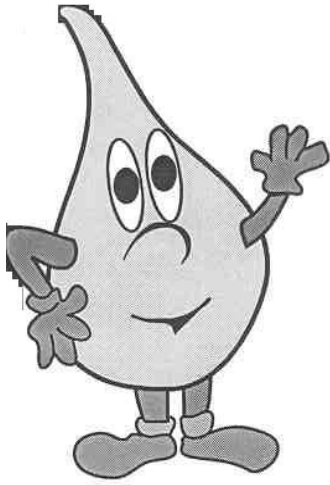
Wellesley's water demands are now challenging the capacity of our water supply. A continuation of these demands may adversely impact our ability to meet essential needs and may jeopardize water quality. Excessive lawn irrigation can deplete wetland environments and can increase the potential of drawing contaminants to drinking water wells.

You can voluntarily help us now by...

- Reducing your lawn irrigation by 20%. If you have an automatic timed system, please shorten the watering period by at least 20%.
- Irrigating only once per week to encourage deep rooting of the grasses.
- Directing all irrigation to appropriate areas (do not water onto pavements).
- Irrigating during low evaporation periods, namely between 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
